

Feisty Choir Terms and Conditions

In joining the choir you are agreeing that Feisty Choir is a women-only space. A safe, co-operative and positive creative space for making music.

Accepting these Terms & Conditions gives your permission to use any photographs or video footage from rehearsals and performances. These may be used on a social media or on a website. If you have any objections, please make them known when you join.

Members of the choir agree to pay their subscriptions by Bank Transfer in advance of rehearsals or when requested. There is no refund for missed rehearsals.

However any refunds of termly fees or part of the total can be given at the sole discretion of the Musical Director and will depend on the circumstances if applied for.

If there is any change in membership fees, members will be notified.

If for any reason the Director is unable to run a session, rehearsals will be re-scheduled or lead by a cover teacher.

The Musical Director reserves the right to decline membership of the choir or ask any member to leave without explanation.

Any grievances are to be raised with the Choir Leader privately outside rehearsal time.

Ethos

Although members are not expected to have had formal musical training they will be expected to sing in tune, hold a part and blend with the other voices and keep time.

Members are expected to learn and memorise lyrics and harmonies as directed for performances.

Expectations are that you'd put in some extra time especially before performances so everyone pulls their weight equally when singing together and you are not relying on others. Resources are provided for this purpose and must not be shared outside the choir.

Safety

Members are responsible for their own health and safety during rehearsals .

The Leader of Feisty Choir is a sole trader and covered by Public Liability Insurance.

Members are responsible for their own belongings.

In accordance with the Data Protection Act, Feisty Choir will hold personal contact information, but will not pass this on to any external organisations.

Covid-19

Refrain from rehearsals if feeling unwell.

In the unfortunate event of a National Covid Crisis the Leader will reserve the right to temporarily run rehearsals on Zoom.
