Accepting these Terms & Conditions gives your permission to use any photographs or video footage from rehearsals and performances. These may be used on a social media or on a website. If you have any objections, please make them known when you join.

Members of the choir agree to pay their subscriptions by Bank Transfer when requested. Fees are termly and these may change in length at different times of the year.

There is no refund for missed rehearsals. However any refunds of termly fees or part of the total can be given at the sole discretion of the Musical Director and will depend on the circumstances if applied for.

If there is any change in membership fees, members will be notified.

If for any reason the Director is unable to run a session, rehearsals will be re-scheduled or lead by a cover teacher.

The Musical Director reserves the right to decline membership of the choir or ask any member to leave without explanation.

Any grievances are to be raised with the Choir Leader privately outside rehearsal time.

Ethos

Members are not expected to have had formal musical training or to have had singing lessons.

Nobody is expected to read musical notation. All teaching is by ear.

Members are invited to learn and memorise lyrics and harmonies as directed or use lyric sheets or music when made available.

In the lead up to a public performance some resources may be provided to support singers in preparation. These must not be shared outside the choir.

Performances are encouraged but optional.

Safety

Members are responsible for their own health and safety during rehearsals .

The Leader of Feisty Choir is a sole trader and covered by Public Liability Insurance.

Members are responsible for their own belongings.

In accordance with the Data Protection Act, Feisty Choir will hold personal contact information, but will not pass this on to any external organisations.
